## Thrissur City Connect

Thrissur City Connect (TCC) is an online programme for young adults to (re)establish their connection and relationship with Thrissur.

We will be delving into multiple areas such as elements of history, localisation, active citizenry, pop culture and more.

TCC will be an interactive exploration with activities intended to bring one closer to Thrissur and also to oneself.



## Programme Details

Thrissur City Connect is a 5 weeks long exploration from July 02nd to 30th, 2021.

The sessions will be of 1 hour, 15 minutes each (6:00 p.m. - 7:15 p.m.) on Fridays and Tuesdays.

To facilitate a meaningful engagement, the number of participants is limited to 12 and the participants are expected to join in all 9 sessions.

The online gathering will happen on Zoom. The medium of communication will be Malayalam.

The programme is for passionate youth from Thrissur who are seeking meaningful and creative engagements in their city.

It is for those who are willing to invest time to learn and unlearn, and wish to explore the possibilities of a city-based lifelong learning.
